The Production

ISLAND by Starcatchers and Frozen Charlotte is a celebration of the unique relationship between babies and their grown-ups. ISLAND is a new show that we are creating especially for babies from birth to 12 months. Working with musician/composer Rachel Newton there will be a live score and a multi-sensory set created by Designer Katy Wilson, where babies are free to explore and parents can take a moment to reflect on the joys and challenges of new parenthood.

The Producers

Our mission is to inspire babies, toddlers and young children and their grown-ups by including them in high quality live performances and creative experiences that fulfil their right to access a rich arts and cultural life in Scotland regardless of where they live or their background.

Audition Opportunity

A two-hander, ISLAND is a devised piece to be formed by the creating artists in development/rehearsal around the themes of love, isolation, reliance and the push and pull of having a new baby.

Aberdeen-based dancer Laura Booth has already been cast and is a frequent and valued company collaborator. We are looking to cast the remaining role for the show and would be excited to hear from performers that fit the call out brief.
